Dear Parents,

Enclosed please find the most current billing for your child's participation in Y swimming. I've closed out the accounts so the bill should not be quite as lengthy for those returning swimmers. For the "newbies" – bills will be sent monthly and any payment is due by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month.

If you have paid in full for the year, you will still receive a monthly bill which will reflect meet entry fees, etc. Hopefully, watching all more frequently will prevent problems or enable us to deal with them quickly. This billing does not charge the 09-10 season fees yet so many of you will show a negative balance. That is because, as of this mailing, I did not have the roster divided by coaches yet to determine the appropriate amount to bill. Enclosed is a description of fees to help you determine what, if anything you need to pay. If you overpaid in full for the year when registering, I will credit the account and the extra may remain in the account for entry fees or other charges later in the season.

Just a reminder to the experienced parents and some words of advice to the less experienced Y parents:

1. All paperwork dealing with meets should be placed in the **yellow** box at Linsly for Bru
2. All payments should be placed in the locked **white** box at Linsly or mailed for Amy (please note: there are envelopes available by the box-please do not put loose cash or checks in the box)
3. Other paperwork will designate procedure for turning in to appropriate venue

Folders will be revamped now that the deadline for registrations has passed. I will attempt to have swimmer folders at each pool. Please watch email and the website for critical and most recent information. The folders will be used primarily for awards and not so time-sensitive info.

Additionally, each coach has an attendance sheet for their group. I have requested they complete these weekly for a variety of reasons but one of the most important is swimmer safety. Particularly with the younger swimmers, it will help immensely knowing who is where at all times.
