

CREDIT VALUES FOR ALL HOME MEETS

Each job listed below is worth 1 full credit. **There are no partial credits.** If someone covers for you, they do not receive credit, you do. It is your responsibility to sign in and out for the job you are performing at a home meet. You may have a representative sign in/out for you only if they are present and working during that time. If you sign in later than 30 minutes for your job or sign out early before your job ends (unless a chairperson determines you can leave) you will not receive credit.

Only when all volunteer positions are filled (excluding officiating) can you then sign up to earn credits through job training (excluding the following jobs: Set-up/Tear-down, Concessions and Lane Timing). A sign up poster will be made available on the bulletin board prior to home meets. Sign-ups will be on a first come first serve basis. Advanced sign-ups beyond the most recently scheduled home meet will not be accepted (Chairpersons excluded). Credits will be recorded after each home meet and made available for families to review through the season.

1 CREDIT IS EQUAL TO:

1. Officiating (Whole Meet)
2. Computer Operator (Whole Meet)
3. Scoreboard Operator (Whole Meet)
4. Head Timer (Whole Meet)
5. Lane Timer (Whole Meet)
6. Concession Workers
**Concession is split into first half and second half with each shift equal to 1 credit. First half includes set-up and second half includes clean up.
7. Bullpen Helper (Whole Meet)
8. Bullpen Runner (Whole Meet)
9. Meet Set Up and Tear Down/Clean-up (Both required to earn 1 credit)
10. Training for any of the above jobs (Whole Meet)

JOBS THAT CAN BE PERFORMED OUTSIDE OF A MEET:

1. Historian
2. Awards
3. Party/Banquet committee
4. Scholarship committee
